Recreation Class Offerings

Recreational classes are designed to teach technique with basic dance rhythms, patterns, and dynamics. These classes provide repetition with a variety of patterns and styles that are an essential part of your dance education. The beginning of each dance year focuses on teaching proper technique and stretching. Dance combinations will then be introduced, with recital choreography beginning once the students are ready.

- Class sizes are kept to @ 15 students, 10 for Preschool & Creative Movement classes.
 This may vary based on the number of teachers and/or teacher assistants instructing the class.
- Must have a minimum of 4 students enrolled in the class.
- Students may take one or more of the offered genres.

Baby Boogie (Ages 1 ½ -3)

Intro to dance (ballet and creative movement), 30 minute class

Preschool Classes (Typically ages 3-4, but based on skill level)

- Ballet & Tap Into to ballet and tap technique, incorporating creative movement, 45 minute class
- Tumbling Intro to beginner Tumbling, 30 minute class

Petite Classes (Typically ages 5-7, but based on skill level)

- Ballet, Tap, & Jazz Beginner level technique, 90 minute class (30 minutes each genre)
- Hip-Hop Beginner level Hip-Hop movements, 45 minute class

Ir. Classes (Typically ages 7-9, but based on skill level)

- Ballet, Tap, & Jazz Advanced Beginner level technique, 90 minute class (30 minutes each genre)
- Hip-Hop Advanced Beginner level Hip-Hop movements, 45 minute class

Intermediate Classes (Typically ages 10-13, but based on skill level)

- Ballet/Lyrical, Tap, & Jazz Intermediate level technique, 90 minute class (30 minutes each genre)
- Hip-Hop Intermediate level Hip-Hop movements, 45 minute class

Senier Classes (Typically ages 14& up, but based on skill level)

- Ballet/Lyrical, Tap, & Jazz Intermediate/Advanced level technique, 90 minute class (30 minutes each genre)
- Hip-Hop Intermediate/Advanced level Hip-Hop movements, 45 minute class

Dancenastics Classes

Combination of tumbling with Jazz and Hip-Hop technique, 60 minute class (Beg/Int – Level 1, Int/Adv – Level 2)

Clogging

Beginner/Intermediate Clogging technique, 45 minute class

Pom Pon

Pom Pon movements and routines performed to music, 45 minute class (Beg/Int – Level 1, Int/Adv – Level 2)

All Boys Classes (Typically ages 7-12)

- Hip-Hop Beginner/Intermediate Hip-Hop movements for just boys, 45 minute class
- Tap Beginner/Intermediate Tap technique for just boys, 30-45 minute class

Adult Classes

- Classes are offered in a relaxing non-competitive environment
- Tap & Jazz Beginner/Intermediate level technique, 60 minute class (30 minutes each genre)
- Hip-Hop Energetic and fun workout with Hip-Hop movements, 45 minute class
- Beginner/Intermediate Clogging technique, 30-45 minute class

Competitive & Pre-Competitive Dance Companies

Competitive dance line classes are designed to teach students to take their dancing to the next level. Choreography for these students starts at the beginning of the dance season to prepare for competitions throughout the dance year. Below are lists of requirements:

- Students must audition or be recommended by an instructor. Auditions will be scheduled prior to the required summer session. Special arrangements can also be made to schedule by appointment. Please note there is no guarantee that all dancers will be placed on one of our competitive companies.
- A Competitive Agreement Form must be signed by the student, as well as the parent, that states the understanding of the commitment involved in competing. This, as well as a signed Registration Form, must be turned in prior to being considered for one of our teams.
- Final placement is based on skill level, dance style, movement and will solely be determined by the instructors.
- Ballet Technique is required for all dances lines.
- Summer classes are required (schedule will be handed out in May). We understand family vacations may be schedule during this time. Please speak to an instructor to see if different arrangements can be made.
- Workshop offerings will be made available, but are not mandatory.
- Dancers may compete in the following genres: Tap, Jazz, Lyrical, Hip-Hop, Clogging, Contemporary, Open. Within these genre's they have the opportunity to compete in a Solo, Duet, Trio, Small Group, Large Group, Line, Super Group, and/or Production. Final placement will solely be determined by Instructors. Please note that students with less than 3 years of competition experience may only compete within Tap and Jazz on their designated line, unless recommended by an instructor. This includes Solo's, Duet/Trio's, and specialty groups.
- Additional practices may be added prior to competitions and/or performances. Additional fees may apply.
- Workshop offerings will be made available, but are not mandatory.
- We strongly encourage students to attend as many of their classes as possible, especially the weeks prior to a competition. It will be at the instructor's discretion whether or not they feel the student is prepared to perform in a competition. We understand that students will need to miss class due to an illness, as well as school and family commitments. Abusive absences due to other activities may affect the individual performance of the student, as well as the teams. If you do need to miss a class, we ask that you please notify the studio prior to your scheduled class time. It is also your responsibility to get with another team member and see what was covered in class.
- A parent meeting will be scheduled in the fall to determine which Regional's OODA will be attending for the season, as well as the determination of attending a National Convention. Please note there is a 50/50 chance of attending. This is determined by the majority votes of both parents and instructors, with the studio director breaking any ties.
- You are responsible for paying all comp fees, as these are non-refundable by the individual competitions.
- A meeting will also be setup in the fall to demonstrate how hair and make-up must be worn for competitions and performances.

Black Company

- Consists of several different Dance Lines.
- Geared toward the more serious and intermediate/advanced dancer.
- Requires 1 ½ hours of ballet technique per week.
- Will attend 4-5 Regional Competitions

Pink Company

- Consists of several different Dance Lines.
- Requires 1 ½ hours of ballet technique per week, Pink Company C is only required to take 1 hour per week.
- Will attend 3-5 Regional Competitions, Pink Company C will only attend 3. Regional Competitions.

White Cempany (Pre-Competitive)

- This is the pre-competitive Company, see instructor for recommended level.
- Geared toward the more serious dancer that is interested in preparing for competition
- Ballet is required with the option of taking Tap and/or Jazz technique.
- Will attend 1-2 Regional Competitions to compete their Tap and Jazz routines.
- Actual competitions will be based on the Regional's determined by the Completive Team.

- Tuition is due the <u>first class</u> of each month; Cash, Check (payable to OODA), Visa, MasterCard, or Discover.
- A \$10.00 late fee will be assessed for each missed payment.
- A \$25.00 fee will be charged for return checks.
- Tuition is non-refundable. Discounts, refunds, and make-up classes will not be given due to vacations, illness, or severe weather, etc.
- Balances must be paid prior to the last day of classes. Any student with an outstanding balance will not be allowed to participate in the yearly dance recital.

Studio Policies

Schedule & Yearly Registration

- Summer and Fall Schedules for the upcoming season will be posted the first week of May.
- Normal Classes run from September through June Recital.
- We will follow the official Oxford School District schedule for holidays and designated time off.
- Students must register for their desired classes each year. This will guarantee students a spot in the class of their choice for the upcoming dance year. Enrollment is on a first come first serve basis.
- Each year, a registration fee of \$10.00 per student will be required.

Dance Attire & Shoes

- All students are encouraged to wear comfortable dance apparel of any color (leotards, pants, shorts, skirts, etc.), to allow easy movement in class. Tank tops may be worn over leotards. (Please, no jeans).
- Competition Ballet Technique: Ballet shoes, leotard, and pink tights are required. Instructor may allow ballet skirts and shorts.
- Hip-Hop students are allowed to wear comfortable and loose fitting apparel and socks (Please, no jeans).
- Hair must be worn up away from face.
- No dangling jewelry and No chewing gum.
- PLEASE, No Street shoes on the dance floor.
- Ballet Pink leather split sole ballet slipper
- Tap Black leather tap shoe (tie or slip on)
- Jazz Tan/Carmel leather split sole jazz shoe (tie or slip on)
- Hip-Hop White athletic shoe, *never worn outside*.
- NOTE to Competition students shoes will be determined once costumes are selected.

Costumes

- Students will be required to purchase at least one costume for the annual dance recital.
- A \$40 per costume deposit is due by October 15th. This will allow Orion Oxford Dance Arts time to place the order early enough to guarantee delivery by picture day.
- All costume deposits are non-refundable, since orders have already been placed.
- The remaining Costume <u>balances</u> are due by January 30th.
- A \$10.00 late fee will be assessed for missed payments

Pictures

- Picture day will be scheduled in early spring of each year. This will allow students to get a picture with their entire group, as well as individual pictures in their costumes.
- Dance packets and/or pricing will be provided prior to the scheduled date.

Annual Recital

- An annual recital will be held in the Oxford High School Performing Arts Center at the end of each dance year in early June, typically the 1st or 2nd Saturday.
- A dress rehearsal will be scheduled prior to the annual recital. This will allow students the opportunity to prepare for the recital and perform their routines in full costume and make-up.
- Recital tickets will go on sale prior to the actual recital date and will not be pre-assigned seating.

Severe Weather

- In the case of severe weather, dance classes may be cancelled.
- Morning class cancellations will coincide with the Lake Orion School District cancellations.
- For afternoon and evening classes, please check the studio voice mail after 3:00 pm to determine if your class will be held.

Parental Viewing

Parental viewing will be allowed through the viewing windows located at the front of each studio room.

 Once choreography begins, parents will also have the ability to watch their child's progress at the end of each week's class.

Referrals

Receive half-off one month's tuition, of one student, for each new family you refer to the studio that enrolls in the fall session. This must be noted on the new students enrollment form. NOTE: Your referral students must be a paying student, enrolled in classes for at least 2 months before a referral credit will be posted to your account.

Evaluations

Students will be provided with an evaluation at the end of each dance year, which will summarize the students overall progress for the past year. Evaluations will focus on individual strengths and areas that may need more attention, as well as fall class recommendations.

Newsletters/Bulletins

- A monthly newsletter will be provided to each family, informing them of any news and upcoming events.
- The scheduled studio closed dates for the entire dance year will be included on each monthly Newsletter
- A bulletin board will also be visible in the lobby area to list "need to know" information.

Payment/Suggestion Box

A payment/suggestion box is available in the back lobby for parents and students to drop off payments, offer suggestions, comments, and or ask questions in an anonymous manor. Orion Oxford Dance Arts welcomes and encourages open communication between parents, students, and staff.

Fundraising

- Fund raising will be available to help reduce the cost of tuition, costumes, and competition expenses.
- Money earned will be placed in each student's account and can be applied where you see fit.
- A fundraising committee will be formed by parents to coordinate each fund raising activity. Volunteers welcome!!
- Individual fund raising activities will be decided by the committee on a yearly basis.

<u> Academic Achievement Program</u>

- Orion Oxford Dance Arts understands that school comes before dance and we strongly encourage all of our students to achieve high academics.
- Students that bring in their report card and have achieved all A's and B's throughout the school year will be recognized at the annual recital.
